DigniCap Delta Update

DigniCap Delta, the next generation of The DigniCap Scalp Cooling System, was introduced at the San Antonio Breast Cancer Symposium in early December.

FDA Clearance of the device has been delayed somewhat by the shutdown of the U.S. government, but plans for launching the device in the U.S. this spring are progressing.

The DigniCap Delta provides significant improvements over the current C3 device with these features:

- Innovative cooling technology
 Solid-state cooling with precise temperature control
- Smaller profile than previous device
 Single patient unit for flexibility in tight spaces is 54 percent smaller than the current unit
- Device portability
 Mobility to allow post infusion cooling outside of infusion room
- Intuitive user interface
 Up to 80 percent reduction in nursing time per patient infusion versus existing device
- Quick connection
 Comfortable side hose provides simple connection
- Ergonomic design

 Convenient access for clinical staff and patients
- Quiet operation
 Reduced noise and lower heat displacement
