### U.S. Legislative Update

In February Dignitana initiated a Bill with Texas State legislators to provide coverage for scalp cooling. Bill number [HB3984](#) was voted unanimously (141-0) from the House of Representatives, but it was not heard by the Senate prior to the end of the Legislative Session on 27 May 2019 and therefore was not passed this year. The Bill encountered resistance from the Insurance Lobby due to the high number of coverage mandates that were filed this session overall which would increase costs to business. The next opportunity to reintroduce the Bill is January 2021.

A similar Bill in the New York State Assembly was also introduced this Spring. Bill number [A00302](#) was referred to the Insurance Committee in January and was not brought up for a vote prior to leaving for summer break on 19 June 2019. The 2019 New York Legislative Session resumes January 2020.

Dignitana is supporting Legislative interest in several other states and will provide updates when available.
