Approval for the new DigniCap Delta in Australia

In September, Dignitana announced that the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) has cleared DigniCap Delta® for use by health care providers on the Australian market. This means that DigniCap Delta is now available to hospitals in Australia through Dignitana's longtime distribution partner, Aurora BioScience, with first deliveries expected in October. Brindisi Italy Study Demonstrates Success

A study presented at the European Society of Medical Oncology Congress in September 2019 confirms scalp cooling success with DigniCap in 72.7 percent of breast cancer patients at Antonio Perrino Hospital in Brindisi Italy. The study included 158 women with early stage breast cancer who received anthracycline and/or Taxane based treatment at the Brindisi Oncology Department from February 2016 through January 2019. The success of scalp cooling and hair preservation was determined according to the Dean's scale. Read more here.

The rollout of DigniCap Delta continues as scheduled and the new device has been very well-received by doctors, nurses and patients. In the U.S. the phased plan includes Delta machines continuing to replace C3 devices for current customers over the next 15 months,



while additional Delta inventory is also placed with new customers. In other prioritized markets around the world discussions are underway with new prospects to implement DigniCap Delta while also encouraging current customers to upgrade to Delta and add devices to accommodate increased utilization.
